Food rules and guidelines

Food is an essential part of every culture as it is a culmination of history, geography, tradition and everyday life.

Please ensure your participation adheres to the following guidelines.

- **Serve food in sample sizes** prepared **prior** to the event. Cupcake foils and mini Dixie cups are perfect sizes and prevent you from touching the food unnecessarily.
- **Wear gloves** when serving or passing out samples if needed.
- **Include large, clear signs** for potential allergens such as gluten, dairy and specific nuts.
These signs must be visible to all attendees.
- **Ensure proper preparation of food** such as washing of hands, wearing gloves when appropriate, thorough washing of fruits and vegetables and other sanitary measures.
- **Cook all items fully** and completely. Utilize a meat or candy thermometer as appropriate.
- **Include and post a list of ingredients** visible to all attendees of the cultural fair.
